Jerry graduated from high school two years early. He joined the Marine Corps on April 1, 1947. Yes.. he was only 15 years old.. After learning of his age the Marine Corps allowed him to remain in the Corps under the Military Act of 1860 as a Drummer Boy (authorized age 12 year). He never saw a drum or bugle Jerry was assigned to H&S Co. 1st Marine Regiment.

In 1949 he met his wife Jean (15) and soon after they were married. They were married for 63 years.

In 1950 , now 19, he deployed with the 1st Marine Division to Korea. In 1954 he applied for Airborne Interceptor Operator School. Upon graduation he was promoted to Warrant Officer and assigned to the Marine Air Wing (MAW). He flew as a Electronic Counter Measures Officer in various aircraft. He flew combat missions in Vietnam.

Jerry was a well known writer. He books included, "The Raw Edge of Hell" , "Sea Eagle Down" and "Gods of War"


